## UPCOMING NIGHTWORKS - Pokeno Main Street and Roundabout upgrade project

Kia ora.

The Waikato District Alliance is about to start laying a final asphalt road surface, which brings the new Pokeno Roundabout project nearer to completion. The location of this phase of the project will affect you as a full road closure is required.

This letter outlines the information you need, including dates of road closures, detour routes, and contact details.

## What you need to know

These nightworks are scheduled to take place from **8pm Sunday 29 September 2024 and will take approximately 1.5 weeks** to complete, weather permitting.

We will be closing the Great South Road/Pokeno Road intersection between the hours of **8pm and 6am**, on Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday nights. During this time all traffic will be detoured.

Outside of these hours (including Friday and Saturday) the road will be open under temporary speed restrictions through the work zones.

Residents and businesses within the closure points will have access to/from properties. Please follow the direction of the traffic controllers onsite.

Noise, dust and vibrations from the work is expected with these works, which include milling off the existing road surface and laying new asphalt. This will be managed, and we aim to keep these to a minimum throughout the work period.

Emergency services will have full access through the site and to residences within the closure, at all times.

The safety of road users, the community and our teams are incredibly important to us. Please be patient, follow all instructions of our teams and comply with any signage or crew instructions.

We understand this work will cause inconvenience; however, the quality of this final layer is incredibly important to the durability and quality of the final product. This work is necessary to ensure the road/roundabout remains safe and accessible for everyone who travels on it.


## Closure points during nightwork shifts
